DRAGONS THROWN FROM THE ARK AS FCFL NEWCOMERS FLEX THEIR MUSCLES.

Noah's Ark have slayed the Dragons by 240 points to climb to the top of the FCFL ladder after the first round..

The boys from Shark Park put on an impressive display against their nearest rivals, with a host of players posting impressive first up numbers.

Shaun Johnson seems to have gotten over his hamstring injuries that plagued his 2019 season, contributing a handy 95 points. Adam Reynolds, Elliot Whitehead and Tevita Pangai Jr. also scoring heavily.

Dazzlers Dingoes took down arch rivals Papatoetoe Piranhas in the closest match of the round, with a 70 point victory. Darren Bevan delighted with the win after heading into the match as the underdogs, and ending the Piranhas winning streak of 7 games in the regular season.

Defending Premiers Filthy Grubs got off on the wrong foot, falling to Balmain by 169 points. Balmain captain Kalyn Ponga racking up an impressive 162 points that had the Grubs rattled from the start.


The new franchise 2Great4U also fell in the opening round, with Basic B!tches flexing some muscle and scoring a massive 912 points. They broke their own record for most points in a first round clash, where the had scored 823 in the 2018 season. Talia Bevan wasn't mincing words when she spoke of her teams chances in 2020.

Terpin to bring in Peter Hiku and Jake Granville and Rosebery Rampage put the broom through their club, releasing Ash Taylor and E. Guler to sign L. Brooks and R. Campbell-Gillard.
